
DE stands for Open Spaces for Dialogue and Enquiry, seducational initiative promotes a methodology for the oduction of global issues and perspectives in educational texts, such as teacher, adult, higher and secondary cation OSDE has been developed and piloted by a group of cators and researchers in 8 countries and it is hosted by the itre for the Study of Social and Global Justice at the versity of Nottingham.

It offers a methodology for structuring safe spaces for ogue and enquiry where participants feet comfortable to ress themselves and ask any question without feeling parrassed or unintelligent. In order to create such spaces, project proposes:

- 1. The discussion and adoption of basic principles
- 2. a set of procedures for structuring an enquiry
- facilitation guidelines for creating an appropriate ethos for the relationships, exchanges and cognitive processes within the group.



As our lenses are constructed in specific contexts, we lack knowledge constructed in other contexts, and, therefore, we need to listen to different perspectives in order to see/imag beyond the boundaries of our own lenses.



3. All knowledge can be questioned

Critical engagement in the project is defined as the attempt understand where perspectives are coming from and where are leading to lorigins and implications). Therefore, question is not an attempt to break the lenses (to destroy or de-legit perspectives), but to sharpen and broaden our vision.
